DESCRIPTION

Reading Trade Centre comprises a terrace of six trade counter units with partially glazed frontages, allocated parking and designated loading bays designed specifically for the trade and roadside market.

The units are of steel portal frame construction under a pitched insulated roof with profiled metal cladding.

The planning use of the buildings is for B8 (warehousing) with ancillary trade counter use.

LOCATION

Reading Trade Centre is prominently positioned on the busy A33 Reading Relief Road (Rose Kiln Lane) approximately 2 miles from both the M4, Junction 11, and Reading Town Centre.

Reading Station is located 1.3 miles to the north of the scheme.

On a prime pitch at the heart of the A33 corridor, the area has a large number of trade, car showroom, self storage and retail operators. With excellent accessibility and a high volume of passing traffic, local occupiers include Skoda, Honda, Big Yellow, Magnet, Porcelanosa, Home Bargains, Matalan and Harveys.
