A GUIDE TO STOKE NEWINGTON AREA







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With no tube station and out the way of the hustle and bustle of North London, Stoke Newington could arguably be one of the nicest areas north of the City. In this peaceful part of the capital there are great bars, a band of indie shops and a large Jewish and Turkish communities that contribute to a lot of its cuisine and culture.

What you'll find in Stoke Newington is a neighbourhood favouring independent shops and small, highly-rated state primary schools, much-loved Clissold Park, and in the grounds of St Paul's Church in Stoke Newington High Street, the only solely organic farmers' market in the country.

Stoke Newington has a variety of houses, including a smattering of Georgian houses in Church Street, and Victorian houses with streets of terrace houses of varying size and styles. Many of these period properties have been converted into apartments and there are now four times as many flats for sale in the area as there are houses.

Property prices in the area range from £375,000 to £450,000 for one and two bedroom flats, respectively.



RESTAURANTS & CAFES

There is a butcher Meat N16; baker The Spence Bakery and cake shop Ooh Lou Lou Cakery and fishmonger Jaines & Son.

Rasa N16 is a well-established South Indian vegetarian restaurant and Aun is a popular Japanese restaurant and highly-rated.



TRANSPORT

Stoke Newington and Rectory Road
Overground stations are the closets and
sit on the Lea Valley lines. Direct trains to
Liverpool Street take no longer than 20
minutes from Stoke Newington overground.
All stations are in Zone 2.

Bus routes include the 67 to Aldgate via Shoreditch, the 73 to Oxford Circus, the 76 to Waterloo via Moorgate and Aldwych, and other buses also travel to London Bridge, Whitechapel, Liverpool Street, Euston, Clerkenwell and more.
