DEXTER CATTLE (58) TRADITIONAL HEREFORDS (7) & GLOUCESTERS (22)



A good entry of 58 Dexter cattle drew a large crowd and a bright trade for the better types was experienced. **Top was £567 for Thornhouse Lantha** with heifer calf Lavender at foot from M Wright, Barnstaple. M Wright also sold maiden heifers Thornhouse Jagna and Jade at £493.50 and £483. The Champion Banberries April with steer calf achieved £525 from RW & KA Barons, Kingsbridge. Mrs D Willis, Rooksbridge sold both Barnaby Sunflower with heifer calf Peony and Barnaby Petal with bull calf at £399 each. Steers sold to £441 (19m) and £430.50 (18m) from Miss J Ford, Burtle.

Traditional Herefords rose to £567 for Stenick 1 Kelly with bull calf from Mrs J Hackling, Wellington.

Gloucester Cows peaked at £525 for Chilla Bluebell with steer calf from R & L Ashton & Son, Beaworthy.

SHEEP REPORT

A big thank you to the Judges Fiona West, Chris Adamson & Mr K Cartwright for their expert determinations of some very large classes.

Shetland Sheep (92)

A smaller entry of 92 Shetland sheep sold to an overall more selective trade. **A shearling ewe topped the sale when it sold for £378 from V Girardot**, who also sold others at £178.50 and £115.50. Ewe lambs sold to £134.40 from JJ & VA Bloom and £99.75 and £78.75 from S Thwaites. Older ewes sold to £115.50 also from S Thwaites. Shearling rams sold to £315 from V Girardot and £115.50 from R Norton.

Jacob Sheep (37)

A much reduced entry of 37 Jacob sheep met a more difficult trade. Shearling ewes sold to £199.50, £162.75 and £147 from J Jasper; £162.75 (x4) and £126 (x4) from B Pescod. Ewe lambs sold to £136.50 from A Gilbert and £105 from C & C Slee. Shearling rams sold to £168 from K Morish and ram lambs sold to £157.50 and £152.25 from A Gilbert and £157.50 from C & C Slee.

Pig Report (14)

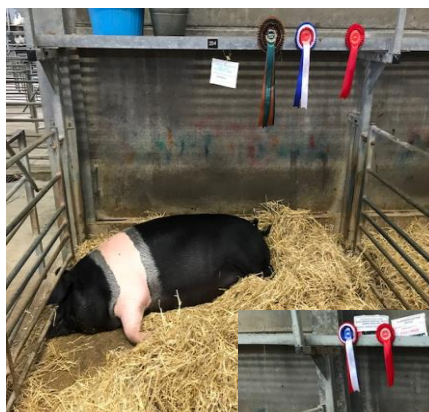
A smaller pig entry for the show and sale than last year.
