
A GUIDE TO LONDON FIELDS

Housing around London Fields is a lot like its East London neighbouring areas. During the second world warm it suffered substantial bomb damage so original Victorian and Georgian properties are sparse with a variety of housing estates. In more recent times, London Fields is beginning to see some really good new developments like the Queensbridge Quarter, as well as the regeneration of some of the older housing estates.

Lardo is a trendy Pizzeria open kitchen, where you can see your pizza being cooked by fire. Off Broadway is a style-conscious New York-inspired bar with an impressive cocktail menu.

London Fields Brewery will definitely quench your thirst. Set up as an antidote to the lack of quality beers in the borough, the brewery has been open since 2011 and offers tours.

Broadway Market has grownd rapidly over the last few years and all for the right reasons. A weekly staple for bargain hunters and fashionistas, the market offers some of London's best vintage clothes alongside an amazing

range of local produce and meats.

London Fields Lido is one of London's wonders; it is the only Olympic-sized outdoor heated swimming pool in the Capitals. The lido is a great place to have on your doorstep, especially during summer.
