A GUIDE TO HACKNEY






Over a period of 20 years Hackney has transformed into one of its most desirable.

During this time, house prices in Hackney have risen more than in any other London borough, however. Houses now sell for well over £1 million in London Fields and in the pretty back streets around Hackney Central.

Regeneration in the area has seen the emergence of a new cultural quarter around the town hall, including renovated Hackney Empire venue, a Picturehouse multiplex cinema and a new library. The famous Mare Street still remains Hackney Central's busy and bustling street for local shops, but a few steps away in the back streets you will find new cafés, bars and restaurants that are thriving.

In Hackney you will find fine Georgian houses around the Clapton Square area and in the streets around St John's churchyard. In Hackney Central, including London Fields, you'll find attractive early Victorian terraces. You'll also find new blocks of flats, converted warehouses and some tough estates of social housing.





RESTAURANTS

The main local shopping street is Mare Street.

There are high street branches of M&S, Primark and supermarkets, but gadget shops, small grocers, bargain stores, and household shops and fabric shops dominate Mare Street.

Much of Hackney Central's attraction is tucked away from the main roads. Wilton Way is where you will find bars, cafés and the well-known restaurant Pidgin — which serves a four-course fixed menu changing every week. In Richmond Road, Lardo specialises in cured meats and pizza. The Lobster Bar is predominately a fish restaurant, and on the corner of Queensbridge Road, The Richmond is a top gastro pub.

There are quiet gardens St John's Church, a green oasis in the heart

of Hackney Central that has become an attraction in recent years. London Fields has a heated lido and Victoria Park is close by.

Hackney Empire is the gem in the borough's cultural crown. It was recently renovated and puts on plays, operas, variety, classical music concerts, comedy and a famous Christmas pantomime.



TRANSPORT

Hackney Central is on the London Overground, commuters change at Canonbury for trains to Shoreditch High Street and for the City. Nearby stations Hackney Downs and London Fields have trains to Liverpool Street taking a maximum of 15 minutes or less. All stations are in Zone 2.

There are a number of bus routes into the City too, including the No 48 to Liverpool Street and London Bridge, the 55 to Oxford Circus, 106 to Whitechapel, 227 to Canary Wharf and many more.
